Dear TCU Students and Families,

Texas Christian University is dedicated to developing tomorrow's leaders by providing an unparalleled academic and student experience. We are committed to offering a TCU education that is excellent in every aspect. Our students' academic experience, student services, campus and activities are all part of our ongoing investment for the future.

Last week, the TCU Board of Trustees met for their annual fall Board meetings. To support sustainability and initiatives to enhance TCU's academic and student experience, <u>the Board</u> approved a 3% tuition rate increase for the 2025–2026 academic year. Need-based aid will increase by 3% to match student and family need. The Neeley School of Business Differential Tuition will also increase by 3%, in line with the 3% TCU tuition rate increase. The Anne Burnett Marion School of Medicine at TCU tuition rate will increase by 3% as well.

The Board reaffirmed its commitment to ensuring that TCU remains accessible to all academically talented and qualified students, regardless of their economic circumstances. The Board also expressed its commitment to financial stewardship and a desire to stabilize tuition increases, given the consistently rising costs of operational expenses.
